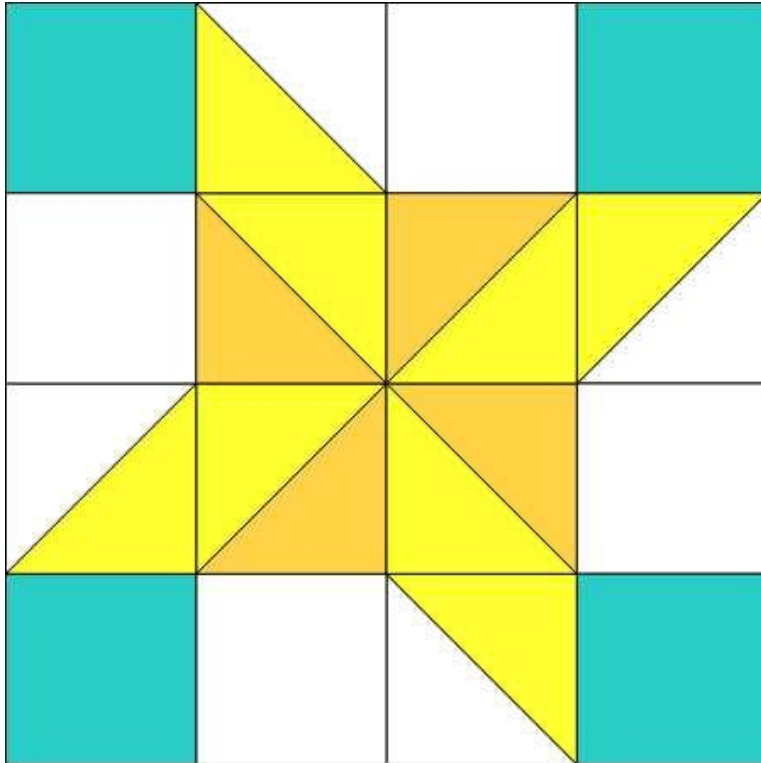


MQ 2019 April BOM



Clay's Choice

Light 'A' squares are for side blocks. Color #1 'A' squares are for the four corners of the block.

Be sure to have a good contrast between Color #2 and Color #3.

For both the twelve and six inch blocks, use 'B' squares to make two HST's with a light/color #2 combination. Make two HST's with a color #2/color #3 combination. To make Half Square Triangles, lightly draw diagonal line on back of lightest squares in each combination. Lay on top of dark squares in each combination. Sew ¼ inch on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Press to dark fabric.

Make ONE finished 12 inch block (12 ½" unfinished).

Trim twelve inch block HST's to 3 ½" inches.

A (4) 3 ½" squares	(4) 3 ½" squares		
B (2) 4 ¼" squares		(4) 4 ¼" squares	(2) 4 ¼" squares

Make TWO finished 6 inch blocks (6 ½ inches unfinished).

Trim HST's to 2 inches.

Light	Color #1	Color #2	Color #3
A ((8) 2" squares	(8) 2" squares		
B (4) 2 ¾" squares		(8) 2 ¾" squares	(4) 2 ¾" squares

Following picture, sew into rows, sew rows together.
