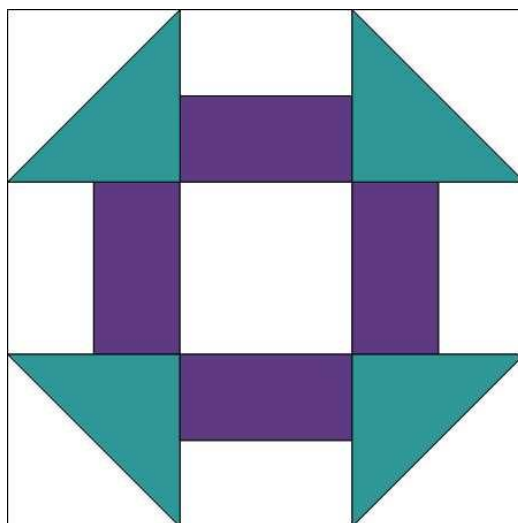


MQ 2019 February BOM



Greek Square

Make ONE 12 inch finished (12 ½" unfinished square)

Light	Dark #1 (for HST's)	Dark #2 (for rectangles)
A (2) 5 ¼" squares	(2) 5 ¼" squares	
B (4) 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles		(4) 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles
C (1) 4 ½" x 4 ½" square		

Make TWO 6 inch finished (6 ½ "unfinished squares)

Light	Dark #1 (for HST's)	Dark #2 (for rectangles)
A (4) 3 ¼" squares	(4) 3 ¼" squares	
B (8) 2 ½" x 1 ½" rectangles		(8) 2 ½" x 1 ½" rectangles
C (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares		

Use 'A' squares to make half square triangles.

Use 'B's to make rectangle blocks.

Use 'C's for center square.

--To make Half Square Triangles: Lightly draw diagonal line on back of light A squares. Lay one light A square on top of one dark A square. Sew ¼ inch on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Press to dark fabric.

For the 12 inch block, trim the HST's to 4 ½". For the 6 inch blocks, trim the HST's to 2 ½".

--Sew the Light rectangles to the Dark #2 rectangles.

--Sew into 3 rows, then rows together.

--You may sew the two six inch blocks together, but don't sew onto the twelve inch block yet. You may want to move them around when you get them all made.
